* Firefox notes: Be advised that the mouse scroll wheel may not be available for map zooming. Also, with Adobe Flash Player in Firefox, the user may constantly see a small "Transferring data..." notification at the bottom of the browser window (this is normal behavior in Firefox with Adobe Flash).

New browser versions have not yet been tested for compatibility with FleetOutlook. They may work, but we recommend you avoid using them until they have been tested for compatibility.

Set your browser zoom setting to 100% when using FleetOutlook, otherwise some maps and reports panels may not fit properly.

For large enterprises, a screen loading with a many vehicles will require more time than the browsers allow. Browsers may display a warning or request to wait for the application to run. Select the appropriate option to continue waiting. To reduce this condition, set the user preference to a smaller group in the hierarchy or try other browsers.
