Introduction

These Release Notes contain details on three newly launched Interactive Reports, as well as updates to several other reports made available in our Version 7.0.2 Reports Release.

Interactive Report Updates

Idle Report Goes Green!

The Idle Report now contains a Carbon Emission column. This allows users to understand the green impact of their idle behavior and the additional benefits of fuel reduction due to less idling. To have carbon emissions calculated in the report, enter an appropriate "idle fuel consumption rate" under the Filters and Options section of the lefthand sidebar. The consumption rate automatically defaults to 0.51 (gal/h).

The Carbon Footprint column presents a value in Metric Tons of Carbon. It is computed as:

Fuel Consumed Rate * Idle Time * 9 (Kg CO₂/gal) * 1 Metric Ton/1000 Kg

Report Scheduling Update

Data for scheduled reports relies on a data loading process that occurs each night. Typically this process completes by 3 a.m. EST but occasionally it can take longer. To ensure that reports generate against the complete data set, you will need to set reports to generate after 5 a.m. EST.

Note: Any existing report currently scheduled to generate before 5 a.m. EST will be modified to run at 5 a.m. EST.

Enhancements

Single Vehicle Record Selector

In Release 7.0.1, the ability to report on a single vehicle was enabled for the Idle, Generator Idle, Stop and Speeding reports. This capability is now available for the following reports: Breadcrumb Detail, Driver Performance, Driver Utilization and Trip.

To select a single vehicle on these reports:

Step 1: Click on the "Change Scope Button."

Step 2: Select a group from the "By Group" tab on the Choose Report Scope screen.

Step 3: Select the "By Vehicle" tab.

Step 4: Select the desired vehicle from the list of available vehicles.

Note: Only vehicles assigned to the selected group will be displayed in the list of vehicles. Those vehicles assigned to groups below the selected group will <u>not</u> be displayed in the list.

New Interactive Reports

We are continuing to add Interactive Reports to FleetOutlook. In this release there are three new Interactive Reports in FleetOutlook. A list of reports, as well as a brief summary, follows:

Landmarks Report

Shows detail and summary views of events associated with landmark stops and geofence landmarks. In addition to the detail level events, the Landmark Report has data on group and driver-vehicle level events related to landmark stops.

Stop Report with Map

This report replaces the Stop Report from the NRP platform that will be retired at the end of November. To more easily visualize a driver's stops at a glance in the context of the day, this updated report displays each stop on a map, in addition to listing the stops with their respective addresses. See below for important information about the Stop Report:

- 1. Stops are numbered in the order they occurred.
- 2. Text records include STOP and Ignition on/off.
- 3. Status types include IDLE and ENGINE OFF.
- 4. STOPS at landmarks are noted along with the category of the landmark.

To access the maps version of the Stop Report, click the Map View tab after choosing the Stop Report.

When generating the map version of the Stop Report, we recommend selecting either a single vehicle, or a group with a small number of vehicles, and a short date range. Since the report produces a map and data records for each vehicle for each day, selecting a combination of multiple vehicles and multiple days can result in an excessively long report.

Breadcrumb Detail Report

The Breadcrumb Detail Report shows every location update from a vehicle and mirrors the data available on the Breadcrumb Detail tab. It provides an easy way to review the textual data in hard copy, or export the data to Excel for further analysis.

The report lists the time, location (address), as well as landmarks, associated work order data if available, and alerts. A sample of the report is below.
