3.29 FEATURE SET

Fix: Job Updates Restricted via API and Deprecated Status Removed

Updated job handling to prevent API users from modifying jobs after creation, except through the Cancel API. Job creation now enforces only supported progress states, and requests that include invalid progress values will return the proper validation errors. Additionally, support for the deprecated InProgressCancelled status still utilized vi API has been removed, ensuring consistent and controlled job state management.

Fix: Cancellation Requests on Completed Jobs

Resolved an issue where task or job-level cancellation requests for completed jobs returned a '204 No Content' response. Clear validation errors will now be returned when attempting to cancel jobs or tasks that are already in a final state (Completed, Failed, or Cancelled).
